## Info for Baseball Families

Hello baseball families... welcome to the Spring 2022 Panther Baseball Season! Our annual flower fundraiser is a fan favorite year after year. We sell quality flowers to our friends, family and the community, and our baseball program benefits. It's a win-win!

Things you should know:

1. Leno's Plant Farm in Mansfield will provide and deliver the flowers again this year.
2. All flats have 18 individual 4" plants which we sell for \$20/flat.
3. **Each player is asked to sell at least 20 flats.**

Things you should do:

1. Spread the word about our flower fundraiser!
2. Have each customer fill out a line on the order form.
3. For each customer, please confirm a) the type of flowers, b) the number of flats, and c) the payment is correct.
4. Collect payment at time of order (cash or check – checks made out to *CHHS Baseball*).

**Order forms and money will need to be turned in by no later than March 9.**

Instructions for turning in order forms and money:

1. Fill in Player name, phone number and class, as well as Parent name and phone number, at the bottom of the order form.
2. Tally your orders across and at the bottom of the form. Double check your totals and the money collected adds up.
3. Place order form and money in the envelope.
4. **PARENTS turn in the completed order form and money to your team parent rep.**  
**\*\* Do not give order forms and money to players to give to coaches \*\***

**Flower delivery is set for the morning of April 9** in the big parking lot behind CHHS (subject to change if the weather doesn't cooperate). A Signup Genius will be sent out for volunteers to help with flower sorting and pick-up. Baseball players can earn community service hours!
